#### Review/Approval of October 21,2021 Board Minutes

Craig Stevens moved that the minutes of October 21,2021 Board meeting be approved. Don seconded the motion. The motion passed.

#### **Committee Reports**

#### Treasurer Doug Brady:

- Doug advised that the payment to Dillons (\$4,600) will be reflected in the Nov. Report.
- Craig Stevens moved to approve the Treasurer's Report and Charlie seconded the motion. The motion passed.

#### **Tournament Director Charles Starr:**

- Charlie advised that we have been working with the Pro Shops to get additional tee times due to the large number of members signing up for recent events.
- Charlie also advised that we are back to 2 carts per group, as we were in the past.

#### Handicap Chairman Ed Foy:

• Ed advised the transition to the new tee colors has gone far better than expected. Leon and Tom are to be commended for doing a great job updating the GG files and communicating the changes to the members. So far only a few of the members have requested tee changes that already had been done by Leon and Tom with the transition. In the last month, there have been 6-8 members who changed tees. The color tees transition must have awakened them to analyze what tees they should be playing.

## Membership Chairman Tom Jones

• Tom stated that we have 500 members. He still has approximately 30% of the applications he receives that need to be followed up on for clarification.

#### Web Site Manager Leon Chapman:

• Leon advised that we should not release information other than CAM numbers, name, and handicap. No phone numbers, email addresses, etc.



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• Leon also advised that CAM numbers are changing again to a 7-digit number and will be eliminating the "D" and "P" qualifiers at the end of CAM numbers.

#### Social Director Craig Boyce

• We are still waiting for confirmation of dates and locations for our 2022 banquets. An email was sent to Kathy and Lorena requesting that information ASAP. We are asking for 1/24/22 in the Kiva Room for the Annual Meeting Banquet and 4/18/22 for the Club Championship/Spring banquet.

Mike reminded us that the 2-cart per foursome rule is back in effect. He also advised that carts being parked on the golf course during shotgun starts is being discussed by the GAC.
